In 2024, the BIA Board of Directors prioritized stabilization and preparation. We continued our evolution from an advisory board to a working board by honing our committee structure to ensure greater effectiveness and efficiency. Specific committee participation allows each board member to use their talents to impact the success of the strategic plan and contribute to a solidly performing organization.

The Finance Committee worked with staff to complete BIAs first single audit. Simple words - heavy lifting! Their tenacity has gifted Benefits in Action with a clean, easy-to-understand financial report that ensures we're all focused on our fiduciary health.

The Governance + Nominating Committee audited endless policies and procedures, revised the Bylaws, and worked with Jane and the Executive Committee to develop a comprehensive succession plan for the CEO position.

The Fundraising Committee helped execute our most successful BOXED annual fundraising event ever! They also investigated various options for diversifying our funding sources and developing a greater understanding of how Benefits in Action can attract individual donors. The Executive Committee, while advising on day-to-day business decisions, vetted and hired an executive search firm, and developed the selection process for hiring our next CEO. They revised the new member board packet and onboarding process as well.

Letter from CEO, Jane Barnes

As Benefits in Action approaches our tenth anniversary in 2025, it's a time to reflect. Founded in late 2015 to serve older adults, we quickly expanded to help adults and families statewide. Our budget grew from \$50,000 to \$5.5 million, but our true impact is measured by the individuals we've served.

navigation to include social security disability, Medicaid waivers, childcare assistance, Connect for Health Colorado, pro-bono taxes, food delivery, and mental wellness programs. We opened offices in Colorado Springs, Commerce City, Aurora, and will soon open in Arvada. Our approach-meeting clients where they are-works!

Partnering with CIVHC, we analyzed nearly six years of data and found our clients successfully receive health benefits 87% of the time for Medicaid. They use their healthcare benefits well, increasing primary care use and reducing emergency room visits-both positive outcomes.

We're reaching hard-to-serve individuals and exceed Colorado averages in serving people of color. We're also joining a cohort with the University of Notre Dame's LEO to design a research project measuring our impact on specific populations—more to come!

Our dedicated staff of nearly 40 are not only skilled but deeply committed to making a difference in our communities.

Our Food Delivery Program

Benefits in Action provided boxes filled with fresh and non-perishable foods to our neighbors who faced barriers to accessing nutritious meals.



Benefit Navigators

Our benefit navigators help our community members apply for benefits that support financial security, food assistance, and access to health care by connecting them with programs like SNAP, Medicare, Connect for Health for Colorado, Medicaid, and other essential resources.



Outreach and Education

In 2024, we reached more than 18,000 individuals through our outreach efforts, delivering informative presentations and engaging online educational sessions on Medicare, Social Security, and other vital resources to empower and support our community.



Unhoused Case Management

In collaboration with the Colorado Safe Parking Initiative, Benefits in Action provides essential care and case management to unhoused individuals and families sleeping in their vehicles.
